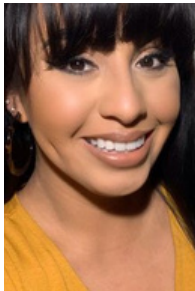

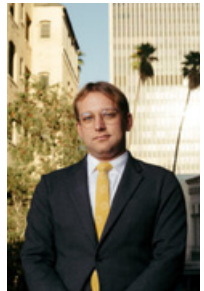
Rebecca Albarran
